- 1) The attendees introduced themselves and also told how many people that they knew by name on their square block.

Other activities will include ghost stories, a fortune teller, and a haunted greenhouse.

He encouraged us to let our city officials (i.e., mayor and city board) know that we want the trail and our neighborhood to be connected to it.
- 6) Sergeant Snook gave a police report and reported that many of the items in the Barton area have been addressed. The area at 3rd and Schiller is slowly being addressed. Many of the items are code items. He also reported that auto breaking and enterings are up downtown but residential burglaries are down.
