Minutes

Kathleen Countryman called the meeting to order:

1) Kathleen gave the membership and treasurer's report in Evelyn's absence. The current balance in the general account is \$2,149.19 and the balance in the safety account is \$913.79. There are currently 17 paid memberships for 2008.

2) Holly gave a report on the June 7th block party in the 200 block of Dennison. Approximately 40 people attended and the purpose of the party was to meet new neighbors and have the neighborhood kids meet each other. Among the activities were a water slide, sno-cone machine and an inflatable "jumpsie house."

3) Kathleen talked briefly about the Neighborhood Conflict Resolution Group, which is located at the Hinton Resource Center. The Group has partnered with the city (but are not city employees) and will work with people, for a fee, to work out conflicts.

4) A discussion was held about restarting a newsletter. Becca Gardner will look at starting one, and the residents attending the meeting thought that the newsletter was an important project for the neighborhood to focus on at this time.

5) Becky Kilmer gave a report on the Community Garden. There are over 30 plots in the garden and she reports that it looks really nice. People have been watering the plots and some people are mowing the garden's common areas. A tree recently fell and did some minor damage to the shed.

6) A brief report was given on the possibility of doing a neighborhood yard sale. It is being considered for sometime in October at the Alert Center. More details will follow.
